

## OVERVIEW

All foreign nationals entering Sri Lanka are required to possess a valid international travel document in the form of a national passport with a valid visa obtained from an Srilankan Mission or Post abroad.

All Individual visa seekers are requested to apply for the Sri Lanka Visa through Online application link [www.eta.gov.lk](http://www.eta.gov.lk) in order to make an application for getting the Sri Lanka visa.

The duly signed physical copy of the application form completed in all respect and submitted successfully, is to be submitted at the concerned Sri Lanka Visa Application Center (SVAC) or directly to Srilankan Mission/ Post, on the scheduled date of interview along with the requisite supporting documents. The instructions for filling the form and scheduling the appointment can be seen at Instructions for Regular Visa Application. Important technical information for filling online Sri Lanka visa application can be referred at Technical Instructions.

Welcome to the Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) official website of the Department of Immigration & Emigration (DI&E) of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.

For a Short Visit to Sri Lanka, (For more info...) travellers should obtain an ETA with effect from 1st of January 2012.

On the basis of reciprocity, citizens of The Republic of Singapore, The Republic of Maldives and The Republic of Seychelles are exempt from the requirement of obtaining ETA to visit Sri Lanka. (For more info...)

The issuing authority of the ETA is the Department of Immigration & Emigration, Colombo, Sri Lanka.

Persons intending to visit Sri Lanka can apply for ETA online. In addition to this option, an applicant may also go for one of the alternative options. (For more info...)

Diplomatic and Official passport holders are exempt from ETA processing fee, only when their applications are
